Curt Eckert was an RLI member for more than 35 years and was the founder of RLI in Illinois in the early 50's. He had four children who graduated from the University of Illinois and he funded a chair at the University. He was a founding member of the Board of Trustees of Belleville Community College in Illinois. He was also a director of the Belleville National Bank.

During his service to the IL Farm and Land Chapter of RLI, he served in all officer positions and was presented with the Illinois Farm and Land Broker Award in 1979, the first such an award was given.

His positive and compassionate attitude was a hallmark of Curt. He attended more than 20 RLI National meetings and was appointed by the Illinois Governor to the community College Board of Trustees.

The Eckert fund is designed to further educational opportunities of the Chapter members.
